## REGULATIONS

## of the XXV<sup>th</sup> Open National Ultramarathon Championships of the Republic of Moldova, Self-Transcendence 24/12/6H Races 3-4 June 2023, "Valea Morilor" Park, Chişinău

- Start of the 24 hours and 6 hours races 3 June, 09:00.
  Start of the 12 hours race 3 June, 21:00.
  Other events (relays, marathon) can be held by the decision of the organisers.
- 2. The course is an asphalt **lap with a length** of 2607 m which runs around the lake. The altitude gain on the lap is 1.70 m.
- 3. **Registration** takes place on this page: <a href="https://md.srichinmoyraces.org/super">https://md.srichinmoyraces.org/super</a>.
- 4. The **minimum qualification** for \*) the 24 hour race is a successfully completed 12 hours race; \*) to participate in 12 and 6 h races the qualification is a successful finish in the marathon (42 km 195 m). Athletes should wear appropriate clothing: running jersey/T-shirt, running pants.
- 5. Entry fees: 24 hours 500 lei (25 euros); 12 hours 400 lei (20 euros); 6 hours 300 lei (15 euros). Registration deadline is 21 May, 2023.
- 6. The participants' **check-in and bibs pick up** will take place on June 3<sup>rd</sup> in the START/FINISH zone: from 08:00 to 09:00 for the 24 hours and 6 hours races, and from 20:00 to 21:00 for the 12 hour race.
- 7. All athletes should provide a certificate with a **doctor's permission** and **medical insurance** (it can be purchased independently or from the organisers during the check-in). The organisers guarantee medical care for athletes only during the competitions.
- 8. The organisers will provide **basic vegetarian food**. Athletes with special preferences should take care of their own food.
- 9. **A tent** will be set up in the start zone for changing clothes and storing personal belongings. For individual rest we recommend that the participants set up their own tents.
- 10. **Winners** of the respective events are determined according to their ranking in the following age categories: 18-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70+ years.
- 11. The **awarding ceremony** will take place on June 4 at 11:30. Each participant will be awarded a diploma. The overall winners (1 man and 1 woman) will receive money prizes, medals and diplomas; the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> finishers in their respective age categories will be awarded medals and diplomas.
